1. Apologies for Absence – Cllr Chris Hutchings, Rev Jonathan Poston, Cllr Anne Knyhynyckyj and Cllr Pat Antcliff.
2. Confirmation of the minutes – the minutes of the meeting held on Monday 22 June 2015 were confirmed as a true record of the meeting.

3. Matters Arising

It was confirmed that the skip would be delayed until Spring to avoid damage to the grassed area. A full refund had been received on the new Honda mower that had broken down soon after purchase.

It was reported that the Rectory hedge had been trimmed and was looking good. There was recognition that the general maintenance of the Churchyard was becoming more difficult with the area of burial plots being extended each year coupled with more profuse growth over that past couple of years. This necessitated the engagement of an outside contractor to help Mr Watts when he was away from work or after a lengthy period of wet weather. The volunteer who had been treating weeds at the Church was retiring and while Mr Harrop was taking over in the short term there was a need to look for another volunteer who would be qualified to do the work.
